

Apart from the final examination, students performance is reviewed through unit tests, quarterly examination, half yearly examination pre-board and internal assessment during the year.

# Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation

Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) refers to a system of school based evaluation of a student that covers all aspects of a student development. It is a developmental process of student which emphasizes on two fold objectives. These objectives are continuity in evaluation and assessment of broad based learning and behaviourial outcomes on the other. The term 'continuous' is meant to emphasise that evaluation of identified aspects of students 'growth and development' is a continuous process rather than an event, built into the total teaching-learning process and spread over the entire span of academic session. It means regularity of assessment, frequency of unit testing, diagnosis of learning gaps, use of corrective measures, retesting and feedback of evidence to teachers and students for their self evaluation. Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation

The second term 'comprehensive' means that the scheme attempts to cover both the scholastic and the co-scholastic aspects of the students' growth and development. Since abilities, attitudes and aptitudes can manifest themselves in forms other than the written word, the term refers to application of variety of tools and techniques (both testing and non-testing) and aims at assessing a learner's development in areas of learning, like:-

## Computer Lab


The School has well equipped, fully air conditioned computer laboratories consisting of a total of 25 terminals. With updated operating systems and high speed processors.




#### Filter Water

## Competitive Exam Preparation

Its is very important to choose the right subject just after class x, so for which the councelling and aptitude test is organised to evaluate their capabilities and choose right path.

School guides the students for preparing themselves to appear in competitive exams for English, Medical, Commerce, Management like IIT, AIEEE, PET,PMT,CPT, CS, CA, IELTS, GMAT. It also organises separate coaching class for above exams preparations.

## Rules & Regulations

#### 1. Prizes and Certificates

The school awards prizes and certificates each year in the month of January on an annual Prize-Giving-Function. Prizes and certificates are given on academic competition, games, fancy dress and other extra curricular activities

#### 2. Home Work

Any home work that is given should be entirely child's effort. Parents may guide, but should not make any change in the set work. Parents are requested to check the work diaries daily and should countersign any message written by the teacher.

#### 3. Attendance

Student should not be absent from school without an application or telephonic intimation from Parents or Guardians, stating the reason, for the absence.

No student will be allowed to go home in between school time without special reason, that too intimated by parents themselves.

#### 4. Fees Payment

The prescribed fees structure attached has to be followed strictly and all the payment has to be done on time. The delay may lead to fine & if a delay of 30 days arise then the school may terminate the admission. Any Fees or payment made towards school is not refundable.

#### 5. Disciplinary Committee

This committee is formed according to the bylaws of the school, it consist of 5 to 7 members (Teachers & Staff Members) who are authorised to take any disciplinary action against any student.

6. No Objection Certificate Student's must apply for NOC before appearing for final exams.











































# Regular Assessment

All Assessment schemes are completely based on the methods drawn & guided by the CBSE.

The prime focus of the School is on

- Innovations in teaching-learning methodologies by devising students friendly and students centered paradigms.
- Reforms in examinations and evaluation practices.
- Skill learning by adding job-oriented and job-linked inputs.
- Regularly updating the pedagogical skills of the teachers and administrators by conducting in service training programmes, workshops etc.

The Scheme of assessment relating to student's performance and attainment is based on unit tests at regular intervals followed by examinations at the end of each term. Besides this we have the internal assessment method, whereby a child's progress is judged not only by his studies but also by the overall performance throughout the year including extracurricular activities.

The aim of the Scheme is to reduce the heavy dependency on annual examinations thereby distributing the burden of studies evenly throughout the year and making it less cumbersome for students.

# For Class I- X & XI – Grading System

- The School conducts unit tests, two terminal exams & one Annual exam during one academic year. Promotion to the next higher class is strictly based on the basis of the annual average calculated on the basis of the following assessment scheme.
- The school follows CCE (Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation) upto class X. Under this students are continuously evaluated throughout the session and are graded on a 10 points scale instead of numerical marking system, as per guidelines provided by the CBSE New Delhi.
- Those who secure qualifying grade (D and above) shall only be eligible for admission in higher class.
- Students can opt for Maths, Biology, Commerce stream with Computers/ Hindi / Informatics practices / Physical / education/ fine arts after securing good marks in the X board exam.
- Change of subjects in class XI may be allowed by the Principal, but not later than 30th of September. Moreover no candidate shall be permitted to change his subject of study after passing Class XI.
- To follow up the performance of the students, parent teacher meeting are arranged twice in a session. In addition. Parents have a facility to meet the concerned teachers regarding their wards every Saturday after teaching classes.
- Extra classes for weak students are also arranged before the examinations apart from revision classes.


